REMARKS

- [3] International Students will have to pay an additional International Student Fee of RM2,500 per year and Security Deposit of RM1,000 (refundable).



Scholarships and Study Grant

A) ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP (First Semester Scholarship)

For the first semester, the percentage of a tuition fee waiver is based on CGPA of Bachelor's Degree.

B) PROGRESSIVE SCHOLARSHIP (For Subsequent Semesters)

The candidate's eligibility for the progressive scholarship will be assessed through the semester's progress report, and other criteria are as below:

- Must be registered as a Full-Time XMUM student for the postgraduate programme.
- Must NOT be sponsored by or receive a salary from any Federal/State/Statutory Bodies or any other organization.
- Candidates with a good publication record will be given priority.

For progression to subsequent semesters, the criteria for maintaining scholarships are as follows:

Criteria	Requirement
Academic results	CGPA > 3.50
Face-to-face interview	Satisfactory Progress Report
Teaching assistant	100% tuition fee waiver 8-12 hours per week
Teaching assistant	50% tuition fee waiver 4-6 hours per week

*** SERVICE REQUIRED FROM SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS**

- Teaching assistant students receiving 100% scholarship should work for the department for at least 8 hours per week.
- Research assistant students receiving 50% scholarship should work for the department for at least 4 hours per week.
- The service can be in terms of being a course tutor, grading homework, and providing academic assistance such as helping the department to run seminars, organise events and invigilate exams.

C) STUDY GRANT (For the entire duration of studies)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Students are only eligible for either a scholarship OR a study grant for any academic year.
- Scholarships will be reviewed every semester.
- Students that fail to maintain scholarship but are eligible for study grant can apply for study grant after they lose the scholarship.
- The scholarship recipient is required to assist the academic member in several services. The service can be in terms of being a course tutor, grading homework, and providing academic assistance such as helping the department to run seminars, organise events and invigilate exams.
