• SERVICES REQUIRED FROM SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS*

- Students receiving 100% scholarship should work for the department for at least 8 hours per week (for each long semester).
- Students receiving 50% scholarship should work for the department for at least 4 hours per week (for each long semester).

*The service can be in terms of being a course tutor, grading homework, and providing academic assistance such as helping the department to run seminars, organise events and invigilate exams.

*PhD candidates that are in their last two (2) years of studies might also be assigned to teach an entry level undergraduate subject as a course tutor.
