# Pathway for English Language Requirement for International Students

## 1. The Rationale

All international students who have not fulfilled the English test requirement for their preferred course of study will have to enrol in the university's Intensive English programme.


### 2. Placement

In order to equip internationals students with an acceptable level of English proficiency and to ensure positive learning outcomes, the English Language Education Centre (ELEC) requires all international students to sit for an internationally accredited Versant English Placement Test (VEPT).

## 3. The Process

- i) Prior to enrolling in the IEP course, international students will be scheduled to sit for the VET which takes approximately 50 minutes.
- ii) This will be followed by an individual face-to-face speaking test with an ELEC lecturer.
- iii) Following the results of the English placement test, students will be placed in either the Pre-intermediate or Intermediate levels of the English intensive programme.
- iv) Each level lasts for a semester (16 weeks) with an average of 16 face-to-face teaching hours and 3 hours of blended learning.
- v) At the intermediate level, students may start preparing for either the IELTS or MUET-on-Demand test.
- vi) Students who have met the English test requirement at this stage will attend a Special English language Bridging course (SELB) which paves their transition to undergraduate studies. They will be taught study skills, stress and time management, academic writing and critical thinking skills.
- vii) Students who have not met the English test requirement will attend intensive test preparatory workshops to help them obtain the required test scores to gain entry to their preferred undergraduate course.
